STUDENT PROGRAM BOOKING - 2010



Attached is the application form for a booking at Maroon OEC for 2010. As an Education Queensland school Maroon OEC focuses on student learning. Maroon OEC facilitates outdoor education programs in a range of educational environments using a variety of challenging activities. To maintain our focus on learning and safety we require schools to commit to the following booking conditions:

1. Meaningful Educational Focus

The most successful Maroon OEC programs:

- a. Have clear and strong links with the school and everyday life of the students.
- b. Emphasise the educational purposes of the program to the students.

The information hosted on our website (www.maroonoec.eq.edu.au) should be used as a guide for planning and developing a program focus.

2. Attendance at Co-ordinator Workshop

To provide a reasonable duty of care for students at a residential camp the organising teacher must visit the venue prior to the camp. **It is expected that NEW school coordinators for 2010 attend the Co-ordinator Workshop conducted at Maroon OEC.**

The aim of this workshop is to familiarise teachers with facilities, operating procedures, responsibilities and educational opportunities offered through Maroon OEC. **The workshop will be conducted at Maroon OEC on Wednesday 9th December, 2009.**

3. Distribution of information

Schools must distribute all relevant Maroon OEC information (or their equivalent) to students, parents and teachers. This information allows students, parents / guardians and teachers to make a considered decision regarding their participation in a Maroon OEC program.

4. Accurate numbers

Maroon OEC conducts its bookings process up to 18 months in advance. We rely on schools to inform us as early as possible of any significant change in student numbers.

5. Accompanying Teachers and Adults

Maroon OEC requires schools to bring one teacher for each group of 23 students and sufficient extra staff and parents to meet the needs of the students and the demands of a residential program. It is also advised that schools bring no more the 2 adults for each group of 23 students except in special circumstances.

6. 2010 Costs

New meal prices are in place for the 2010 school year. A five day program will now cost \$111.10 for EQ Primary students and \$125.50 for EQ Secondary students. This includes all meals and catering, accommodation and use of resources and facilities. More detailed costs are on the website.

The closing date for applications to be received at the Maroon OEC is Friday 19th June 2009. Schools will be notified of the outcome of their application by early Term 3. Please post or fax your booking application form to:
